Dear Parents and Guardians

END OF TERM PROGRAMME

We have reached the end of our academic year and can now use the rest of this term to shift the focus of our balanced curriculum to social and fun activities as part of our preparation for 2019.

Herewith a summary of the programme for the rest of the term:

RETURN OF SCRIPTS PROGRAMME: 27 – 29 November (School ends at 13h00)

Learners are currently following a special timetable where they have the opportunity to see all their scripts as well as receive their final year marks for all subjects.

FRIDAY, 30 NOVEMBER (School ends at 12h30)

The day will start with a data check where learners can double-check that all results were captured correctly on the recording and reporting systems. This will be followed by the launch of the Interschools theme for 2019 as well as House meetings in preparation for the 2019 Interhouse competitions.

- Interschools mass display and cheerleading for all other age groups
Learners to be dressed in school uniform

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WEDNESDAY, 5 DECEMBER (School ends at 13h00)

This day will focus on Interschools athletics preparation:

- Athletics prelims for U17 (*learners born in 2002 and 2003*)
All U17 learners must arrive at school in the official sport / phys ed clothing
- Interschools mass display and cheerleading for all other age groups
Learners to be dressed in school uniform
- The day will end with House meetings

THURSDAY, 6 DECEMBER (School ends at 13h00)

This will be the official Interhouse Summer Sport competition for Basketball, Hockey, Cricket, Softball and Tennis. All participants must be dressed in their sports gear. FRIDAY, 7 DECEMBER (School ends at 12h30)
