IMPLEMENTATION OF NEXT PHASE

Following the announcement made by Minister Motshekga on Thursday 2 July 2020, our plans sent to all parents regarding the implementation of phase two for all FET learners (Grade 10 to 12), are adjusted as follows:

Grade 10 must remain home next week as we await further guidance from the Education Department.

Grade 11 will return to school as planned on Wednesday, 8 July 2020.

Grade 12 write Afrikaans Paper 3 on Monday 6 July 2020 and English Paper 3 on Wednesday 8 July 2020, and as this was scheduled before the announcement by the minister, we cannot adjust the assessment program at this late stage. After the completion of the language assessments, the Grade 12 learners will follow the **new** timetable in their **new** class groups. Grade 12 learners must ensure that they consult the list attached to the Covid-19 FET Information Circular, in order to report to the correct new class groups for screening on Monday, 6 July 2020.

COVID-19 CASES UPDATE

Mrs Gallie has been discharged from hospital and is recovering slowly at home.

We have had a second learner test positive this week, but this matric was not at school from 22 June 2020, as she was in quarantine due to close exposure to a family member.

We currently have quite a number of learners and teachers in quarantine, as family members have tested positive.
